EPIPHANY BLESSINGS OF HOMES

According to ancient tradition on the Feast of the Epiphany Christians bless their home by marking the door and filling the house with the fragrance of blesses incense. I invite you to adopt this custom in your family. The family gathers to ask God's blessing on their home and those who live in or visit the house. It is an invitation to Jesus to be a daily guest in our lives, our home, our comings and goings, our conversations, our work and play, our joys and sorrows. The traditional way of doing this is to use chalk to write above or on the main entrance of the house or room: 20 + C + M + B + 24. The initials remind us of the traditional names of the Magi - Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar - and also stand for the Latin motto: Christus mansionem benedicat, "May Christ bless this house." "Chalking the door" is a way to celebrate and literally mark the occasion of the Epiphany and God's blessing of our lives and home. May this Epiphany Blessing be a reminder that Christ is incarnate in the love and care we manifest to each other in our ordinary daily lives together.
